N2YJY, President, called the meeting of the ARAST General Membership to order on September 18, 2014, at 7:10 pm. The meeting took place at the Horseheads Town and Country Fire Department, 130 Gardner Road, Horseheads, New York.

Roll Call

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> – Given by N2AMW. A motion was made second and approved to accept the report.

Membership Committee – KD2DGD reported that he has set up a new category known as Silent Keys so that he can keep track of our members who pass away. He is accepting membership renewals and new membership forms for the 2015 year. Our Membership year runs from October 1 – September 30. He will have forms at the ARAST table at Hamfest.

Education Report – KD5KVI reported on Jamboree on the Air (JOTA). He stated that Kelsey has enough equipment and would like our help by talking to the Scouts on the Air October 17-19. He is working on setting up several trainings- one for new hams and one for the General Licenses. It was mentioned by N2OJM that we may have a signup sheet for those who would like to take a tech and/or a general license course.

<u>Repeater Report</u> – N2EUS – County is proceeding on Comfort Road. The Tower and antennas are up, hardline is run and everything is grounded. The power is run into the building but not hooked up yet. The heating and cooling units need to be put in as well as a couple of Microwave racks that still need to be installed. Hawley Hill – the county is in talks with Channel 18 over this property.

N2EUS pointed out that adding a UHF amplifier, a UHF pre-amp unit, and two VHF preamp units could assist in increasing the radio distance at the tower site. He pointed out that for \$1,680 we could purchase this system and the miscellaneous materials needed for installation. Barry explained that he requested funds from the Sheet Metal Workers' Brotherhood Fund for assistance with this project. He received a grant for \$800 toward this specific project. He is working to solicit additional grants to cover the cost of this project.

Hamfest Report- KD2DGF asked for the names of those who would like to help with the fest. He reported that Kathy Sauder sent her regrets that she will not be joining us this year as she is working third shift. We have 17 tables reserved as of today. This includes KJI Electronics and Grace Technologies. It has also been reported that Quick Silver will be attending as well but they have not reserved tables. He also received an email that the Deputy Zone Director from the ARRL would like to set up an ARRL Table. 8 tables for Norm's Stuff.

Further, four people have called the Hamfest Hotline to inform us that they will be taking the tests for tech and general licenses.

It was discussed that we would use a simplex frequency for the inside communications. 146.580 will be the frequency.

<u>CCARES</u> – N2OJM reported on his need for assistance with the Wine Glass Marathon on October 5. He needs twice the number of communicators as he has already. The List will be placed on the Event google map so that everyone will be aware of it.

For our use the best repeater will probably be the Corning repeater.

Full Marathon Runner Bibs will be White with 4 digit numbers. The half marathon Bibs will be yellow with four digit number.
